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# Annual Medical Service Awards Nomination Form

Please e-mail (preferred) or mail the completed form with required documentation by August 31 of each year to the Lee County Medical Society at the address listed at the end of this form.

We strongly encourage the candidates' curriculum vitae be included with this nomination form. Pertinent supplemental materials may also be appended. All nominees must be US citizens and legal residents of Lee County. For Physicians, they must be members of the Lee County Medical Society and, if still practicing, their primary practice located in Lee County.

**Remember the deadline for submission is August 31 of each year. Any nominations presented after the deadline will not be accepted and will have to be resubmitted to be considered for the following year.**

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## Physician Award Categories:

### *Award for Citizenship and Community Service*

For outstanding leadership and/or public service above and beyond the call of duty as a practicing physician. This can include service within the local community or abroad, such as, but not limited to, contributions to international aid missions or other pro bono work.

### *Scientific Achievement Award*

This award is given in recognition of outstanding work in the areas of scientific medical research. This will include both basic science and clinical research. Work done while residing within the county will be emphasized although previous research outside of the region will be considered.

### *Award for Health Education*

This award will recognize the professional or public health education activities of a physician. This may include those exemplary physicians who educate other physicians and health care workers. Physicians involved in non-promotional community service education will also be considered.

### *Award for Leadership in Medical Ethics and Professionalism*

This award will underscore the County Medical Society's continuing dedication to the principles of medical ethics and the highest standards of medical practice. The ideal candidate for the award would:

1. Be active now or in the past in organized medicine.
2. Be dedicated to the principles of medical ethics and the highest standards of medical practice.
3. Have made an outstanding contribution through active service in medical ethics activities, e.g., (1) by serving on an ethics committee or commission, or (2) by improving the profession's effectiveness in upholding its ethical standards through advocacy of policies, provision or organization of services, and/or by scholarship (writings) that demonstrate effective leadership in ethics.
4. Have distinguished himself/herself as a leader in biomedical ethics to merit nomination.

### *Lifetime Achievement Award*

Nominees should have contributed substantially to the goals and ideals of the medical profession. The nominees' contributions shall have been sustained and substantial over a significant term of service in the respective County.

## Non-Physician Award Categories:

### *Non-Physician Award of Appreciation*

For exemplary and a lasting contribution to the medical profession as a non-physician member of the medical profession.

### *Distinguished Layperson's Service Award*

This award shall be made to a person not of the medical profession who has contributed to the achievement of the ideals of medicine through the advancement of medical science, medical research, medical education or medical care.
